- 1. Short title and commencement.—a) This scheme is called "Empowering Schedule Tribe (ST)//Schedule Caste (SC) Communities using Information and Communication Technology (ICT) Tools".
- b) The scheme shall come into force from the date of the notification of its publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. Introduction.— The Department of Information Technology under its vision to create a suitable IT eco-system has formulated this scheme, namely "Empowering Schedule Tribe (ST)/Schedule Caste (SC) Communities using Information and Communication Technology (ICT) Tools" under Tribal Sub Plan (TSP) & Schedule Caste Sub Plan (SCSP) to provide IT related trainings to the ST/SC communities free of cost. This scheme shall be implemented through the various IT Knowledge Centers (ITKC) setup across the State.
- 3. Objective of the scheme.— a) The following are the objectives of the scheme:
 - To provide basic computer skills to the local youth, housewives and other citizens belonging to the ST/SC Community.
 - ii) To provide various Job oriented IT Training courses.
 - iii) To provide structural training programmes depending on the needs.
 - iv) To make at least one person in each family in the State IT literate.
- 4. Scope of the scheme.— The Department through M/s ITG empanels training centers to conduct IT courses under the banner of IT Knowledge Centers (ITKCs). This scheme is applicable in all the empanelled ITKCs. Students belonging to the Schedule Tribe (ST)/Schedule Caste (SC) communities can take up any of the courses available at the ITKCs as per eligibility. These courses will be available free of cost to the ST/SC communities.
- 5. Eligibility under the scheme.— a) The citizen/student must be of Goan Origin.
 - b) The citizen/student must belong to ST or SC Community.
 - c) The scheme is applicable for all the courses offered under ITKC and available at the IT training centers empanelled by M/s ITG.
 - d) An applicant will not be allowed to avail the benefit for the same course in multiple ITKCs.
- 6. Procedure for applying.— a) The application forms are to be submitted at the empanelled ITKCs through which the applicant would like to avail the courses.
- b) The applicant is required to submit the following documents while applying;

- 7. Quantum of Financial Assistance under the scheme.— a) M/s Info Tech Corporation of Goa Ltd. (M/s ITG) is nominated as the implementing agency for the proposed scheme.
- b. The Department of Information Technology shall provide a Grant-in-Aid under the Tribal Sub Plan (TSP) and the Schedule Caste Sub Plan (SCSP) to M/s ITG on a yearly basis for providing free IT related trainings to the ST/SC beneficiaries.
- 8. Pattern of Assistance.— a) The grants shall be utilized exclusively for providing free IT related trainings to the ST/SC beneficiaries.
- b) The entire amount of the grants should be utilized within a period of one financial year and only for the purpose for which it is sanctioned. Any portion of the grant, which is not ultimately required, will be refunded to the Government. After utilizing/refunding the sanctioned amount, Utilization Certificate should be furnished to the sanctioning authority as required under Form G.F.R.—12-C.
- c) No grant shall be paid to any other institutions/voluntary organizations out of this grant sanctioned by the Government.
- d) The Grantee Institution must exercise reasonable economy, observe all financial rules as issued by the Government from time to time while incurring the expenditure.
- e) The amount remaining unspent out of this grant shall be refunded back to the Government Treasury by Challan within 3 (three) months from the close of financial year.
- f) The amount shall be drawn from the Directorate of Accounts on presentation of the bill in Form GAR-32 duly countersigned by the Drawing and Disbursing Officer, Department of Information Technology.
